RE: COVID-19 Guidelines

Williston Members,

The City of Minnetonka has implemented a number of guidelines for the health and safety of our members. Some of these guidelines will be phased in and out as appropriate, while others will be long-term. The City of Minnetonka reserves the right to enforce these guidelines. Your cooperation in following these guidelines is vital to ensure we can keep the facility open.

- All members are required to wear masks entering, exiting or while in the facility, excluding while exercising.
- All members must come workout-ready, which means dressed to participate with a filled water bottle. Water fountains will be limited to bottle fillers only.
- All members and guests must maintain six feet of distance from others in the facility. In order to meet this requirement:
 - Fitness equipment will be spaced out and some equipment will be temporarily unavailable.
 - Small gatherings will not be allowed in common areas throughout the building.
 - Limited lockers/space will be available in locker rooms. Members are encouraged to use individual restrooms and family locker rooms.
- No cash will be allowed for any transaction.
- Limit your visit to those on your membership only. Initially, no guests will be allowed.
- Anyone who is sick or has symptoms of COVID-19 should not enter the facility.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult guardian.
- Members or guests who fail to follow guidelines and staff direction may be asked to leave the facility, and refunds will not be issued.
- Additional hand sanitizing stations are conveniently located throughout the facility.
- Disinfectant spray will be readily available for cleaning equipment.
- Staff will continuously disinfect high-touch surfaces throughout the facility.
- Williston hours have been adjusted to allow for overnight deep cleaning.
- Staff health screening processes will be implemented by the City of Minnetonka
