Williston Members,

It has been nearly one month since we began the phased reopening of Williston Fitness Center, and the City of Minnetonka and Williston staff remain committed to the health and safety of our members.

Please see the below list of updated policies pertaining to our operation during the COVID-19 pandemic. Your commitment and cooperation are incredibly important and will ensure that Williston Fitness Center can remain open and able to serve you. The City of Minnetonka reserves the right to enforce the following policies.

- All members are **required** to wear masks upon entering, exiting or while in the facility, except when exercising.
  - Beginning Friday, July 24, a city ordinance will take effect requiring the use of facial coverings in public buildings in Minnetonka. Masks will be available to you, and you will be required to wear one in all indoor spaces unless you are actively engaging in exercise.
- All members must maintain six feet of distance in the facility. In order to meet this requirement:
  - Fitness equipment is spaced out and some equipment will be temporarily unavailable.
  - Small gatherings are not allowed in common areas anywhere in the building.
  - Limited lockers/space will be available in locker rooms. Members are encouraged to use individual restrooms and family locker rooms.
- Staff will regularly disinfect high-touch surfaces throughout the facility.
- Disinfectant spray will be readily available for member use on exercise equipment.
- Members are **required** to clean their fitness equipment after use. Our staff is working diligently to clean equipment, but it is, and always has been, the member's responsibility to clean equipment after use. Be sure to familiarize yourselves with cleaning procedures upon entering the fitness room.
- Additional hand-sanitizing stations are conveniently located throughout the facility.
- Sweat towels will not be available at this time. Towels should only be used for cleaning purposes.
- Members who fail to follow guidelines and staff direction may be asked to leave the facility, and refunds will not be issued.
- Reservations are required for pool lap lanes.
- Cash transactions will not be allowed.
- Anyone who is sick or has symptoms of COVID-19 must stay home.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult guardian.
- Facility hours have been adjusted to allow for overnight deep cleaning.
- Staff screening processes will be implemented by the City of Minnetonka.
