



## Ranked-Choice Voting Results

November 4, 2025 Municipal Election

### At-Large Councilmember, Seat B

| Candidate                          | Number of 1st Choice Votes | Percent of Votes |
|------------------------------------|----------------------------|------------------|
| Craig Alciati                      | 1,577                      | 11.88%           |
| David D. Biesboer                  | 2,120                      | 15.97%           |
| Kimberly Wilburn                   | 7,773                      | 58.57%           |
| Undeclared Write-ins (UWI)         | 50                         | 0.38%            |
| Overvotes                          | 9                          | 0.07%            |
| Undervotes                         | 1,743                      | 13.13%           |
| Total ballots cast for this office | 13,272                     | 100.00%          |

**Maximum possible threshold to win:** 6,637

**Declared Winner:** Kimberly Wilburn

\*Maximum Possible Threshold = ((Total ballots cast that include votes, undervotes, skipped rankings, and overvotes for the office)/(Seats to be elected + 1)) + 1.

"Maximum possible threshold" means the number of votes sufficient for a candidate to be elected under a first ranked choice tabulation. In any given election, the maximum possible threshold equals the total ballots cast that include votes, undervotes, skipped rankings, and overvotes for the office, divided by the sum of one (1) plus the number of offices to be filled, then adding one (1).
